

ORLGA CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

September 25-27, 2017

RULES: USGA Rules of Golf will apply. The scores must be posted as Tournament scores.

LOCAL RULES: See ORLGA Local Rules Sheet.

DROP ZONES: Only the following drop zones will be in play:

Panther's Run – None

Tigers Eye - #11

Lions Paw - #3 and #6

FORMAT: 54-Hole Individual Stroke Play Event

FLIGHTS: There will be 4 flights. Day 1 Pairings will be determined by USGA Index.

After the first round, Day 2 and 3 pairings will be established using gross score, regardless of flight. The overall club champion can come from any flight.

TEE BOXES: All players will play from the same tee boxes – From the Red Tee Markers on Lions Paw and Panther's Run and the Gold Tee Markers on Tigers Eye.

FLIGHT WINNERS: The player returning the lowest 54-hole gross score in each flight will be declared the Gross winner of the flight. The player returning the lowest 54-hole net score in each flight will be the Net winner of the flight. If there is a tie for 1st place, the winner will be determined by the USGA recommended method. A player may only win once. If a player is both the lowest gross and net scorer, the player will be the Gross winner. The next lowest net scorer will be declared net flight winner.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP WINNER: The player returning the lowest 54-hole gross overall will be the Club Champion. The player returning the second lowest 54-hole gross score will be the runner-up. If there is a tie, players will then move on to Sudden Death until a winner is determined. The overall gross winner and runner-up will not be eligible to win any other prize.

SCORING: Only the Official scorecard per player shall be returned to the Tournament Committee with two signatures. A scorecard is deemed returned when the score is posted on the scoreboard.

PACE OF PLAY: For fairness and enjoyment for all players, please maintain an acceptable pace of play. Keep up with the group in front of you. If a foursome falls behind, the group or individual player will be asked to pick up the pace.

DOUBT AS TO PROCEDURE: RULE 3-3 – If a competitor is doubtful of his rights or procedure, she may, without penalty, complete the hole with two balls. After the doubtful situation has arisen and before taking further action, the competitor must announce to her fellow-competitor that she intends to play two balls and which ball she wishes to count if the Rules permit. The competitor must report the facts of the situation to the Designated Rules Official before returning her score card. If she fails to do so, she is disqualified. Designated Rules Officials are as follows:
