Panther's Run - Nov. 13 & Lion's Paw - Nov. 15

Tee Times: Monday, November 13th PR 7:41 AM - 8:35 AM

Wednesday, November 15th LP 12:05 PM - 12:50 PM

Entry Fee: \$10 (cash) per person to be collected on the first day of play. Turn in fees with the scorecards on day one.

Sign-Up Instructions: Click on the **signup button** below. You will have the option to sign up for both days at once or pick the day of your choice. Just put a check in the box(s) you wish to play and click "Submit and Sign Up" that appears at the bottom of the screen. A second screen will appear to confirm your choice. Click "Sign Up Now". (Should you need to remove your name, just click on the "X" under your name. A second screen will appear reconfirming removal of your name. Click "Yes-Delete". Double check to make sure your name is removed.)

Day One: Panther's Run - Nov. 13th

Format: Better Ball on holes # 1-9 (Full handicap)

Better ball of partners: On each hole, the teams select the lower net score of the partners and records that as the team score. No gimmes and play the ball down. Each team must use at least three scores from each partner. Full handicap with strokes on appropriate holes will be indicated on the scorecards.

Shamble on holes # 10 - 18

Choose the best drive of the partners and then each partner plays her own ball from that spot. Use at least two nets from each partner.

Day Two: Lion's Paw - Nov. 15th

Format: Total Net of Partners on holes # 1-9

Both partners play all their shots and deduct the handicap shown on the scorecard for those nine holes at the end. Both players must put the ball in the hole and can not pick up. No gimmes and play the ball down. Full handicaps are used.

Duck Soup on holes # 10 - 18

Both players in a team tee off, then switch balls. Player "A" plays Player "Bs" drive and vice-versa. Each player hits the second shot. Then select the better of the second shots and from that point until the ball is holed, play alternate shot. The player whose second ball was NOT chosen gets to play the third shot.

Scorecards: Signed and attested scorecards must be dropped off at the conclusion of play each day to the back room of the Pro Shop.

Rules: USGA Stroke Play Rules. No Gimmes. ORLGA local rules apply. Play the ball down. If cart path only (CPO); lift, clean and place (LCP) in your own fairway, one club length no closer to the hole.

Prizes: Teams with the lowest total score over the two-day format wins. Prizes TBD based on the number of participants.

Awards Presentation: Wednesday, November 15th after golf @ Tamers

Miscellaneous: Committee is working with Chef Robert for a light meal for players at the end of day 2 play. Addition fee may be assessed.
