Lion's Paw – March 26 & Panther's Run – March 28

Tee Times: Monday, March 26th – LP - 7:56 AM - 8:50 AM

Wednesday, March 28th – PR - 12:20 PM - 1:05 PM

Entry Fee: \$20 (cash) per team to be collected on the first day of play. Turn in fees with the scorecards on day one.

Sign-Up Instructions: Click on the **signup button** below. Follow instructions on the sign up page to sign up both you and your partner. (Should you need to remove your name, just click on the "X" under your name. A second screen will appear reconfirming removal of your name. Click "Yes-Delete". Double check to make sure your name is removed.)

Day One: Lion's Paw - March 26th

Format: Alternate Shot - Holes # 1-9

On each hole, the partners select who will tee off on the odd holes, and who will tee off on the even holes. Then hit alternate shots until the ball is holed. No gimmies and play the ball down. (The team handicap is 25% of the sum of the partner's handicaps.)

Crier's Nine on Holes # 10 – 18

On each hole, the team selects the lower net score of the partners as the team score for that hole. Each team must use at least three nets from each partner. No gimmies and play the ball down. After the nine holes are played, drop the two highest net scores from the team score. (100% handicaps.)

Day Two: Panther's Run – March 28th

Format: Better Net of Partners on Holes # 1-9

On each hole, the team selects the lower net score of the partners as the team score. Each team must use at least three scores from each partner. (100% handicaps.)

Scramble on Holes # 10 - 18

Both players tee off, then select the best tee shot and then both hit from there. The partners pick the best second shot and both hit from there. This process is repeated until the ball is in the hole. The ball must be placed within one club length of the shot being chosen, and in the same conditions, i.e., if in the rough, must stay in the rough. Teams must use at least two drives from each player. (The team handicap is 35% of the A player, plus 15% of the B player, divided by two.)

Scorecards: Signed and attested scorecards must be dropped off at the conclusion of play each day to the back room of the Pro Shop.

Rules: USGA Stroke Play Rules. No Gimmies. ORLGA local rules apply. Except for the Scramble format, play the ball down unless the course conditions warrant a change, which will be announced before play on both days. **ON PANTHER'S RUN #18, THERE IS NO DROP AREA. THE BALL MUST BE HIT OVER THE WATER HAZARD,**

Prizes: Teams with the lowest total score over the two-day format wins. Prizes TBD based on the number of participants.

Awards Presentation: Wednesday, March 28th after golf @ Plantation Club

Miscellaneous: In the event of inclement weather, the tournament directors will notify the players if the game is canceled and how the tournament will be awarded. We will not be able to reschedule the event, so every effort will be made to be the most fair in awarding prizes.
